IPAV is please to present for the first time a new lecture series looking in detail at the great artistic traditions of Flanders and Belgium from the 15th century to today. For a relatively small country, Belgium has had a disproportionate impact on western art, from the transformation wrought by Jan Van Eyck to the innovative surrealism of René Magritte. Though dwarfed now by France or Germany, Belgium has long capitalised on its position as the crossroads of Europe, beginning in the early great mercantile era of Bruges and Antwerp, to its current role as centre of the European Union in Brussels.

The Principal lecturer is among Ireland's foremost Fine art specialists. In addition, guest lecturers from the universities, art colleges and the commercial art world are invited to lecture in specialist areas.

The lectures will be held over an 8-week semesters in IPAV, 129 Lower Baggot Street, Dublin 2 on Tuesdays of each week from 6.30pm to 9.15pm, two lectures each evening.
