very important speaker Matt Prior, from the UK's Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government, spoke on the very issues that face us all in Ireland, in particular Conveyancing. He spoke about the possibility of a Reservation Agreement and the penalties when its not adhered to, and while its certainly a long way off, Conveyancing, the length of time it takes, as well as the uncertainly for purchasers and buyers alike in the process is a huge worry in England and in Ireland."
