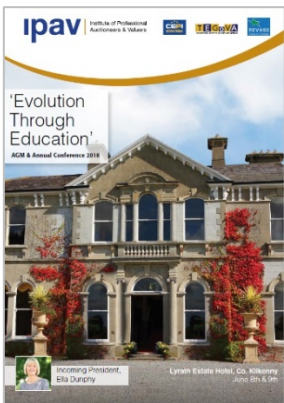
**Blue Book CPD – 8<sup>th</sup> June – Tickets & Calculator!**
