IPAV Student Regulations

Introduction

Refunds for students who withdrawn from the course officially in writing before 31st October are liable for the course administration and registration fees of €400, between 1st November and 31st January are liable for 50% of the course fees and after 31st January are liable for 100% of the course fees.
- 5. A Student must register and furnish all documentation required by the date and time indicated on their application before any letter of offer will be considered.
